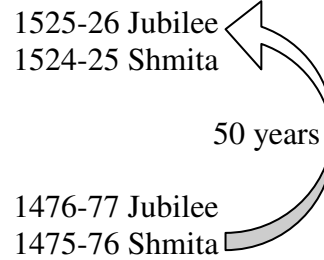
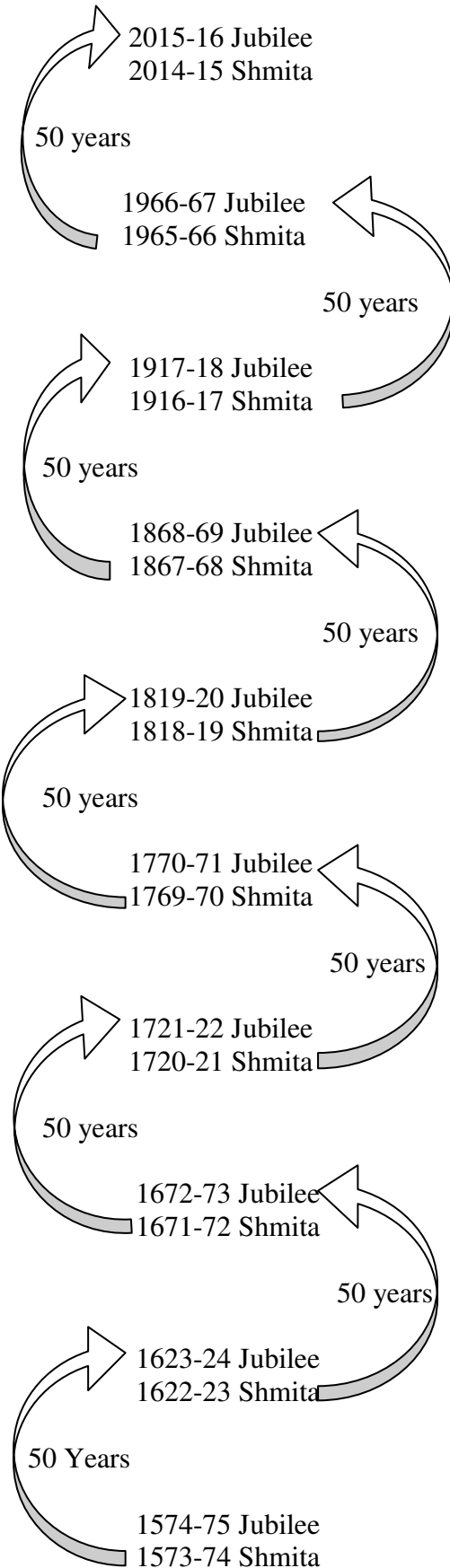


Shmita/Jubilee Timeline

** (odd) 49 years from Shmita to Shmita
** (even) 50 years from Shmita to Jubilee

The key is that each 50th year Jubilee is **also** the 1st year of the next 49 year cycle, vs. the 50th year Jubilee being a separate addition from the 1st year of the 49 year cycle.

Using this approach, the indefinite pattern of repeating 7's, leading up to (odd) 49 years; shmita after shmita is not compromised by the addition of an extra (even) 50th year, while the integrity of the Jubilee occurring every 50th year is maintained within the framework of the repeating 7's, which lead up to a 49th year and then repeat.

*Even though it is not indicated, in between each 49th year shmita are 7 other shmita's, the 7th shmita being the 49th year, since a shmita year is the 7th year. The shmita's listed are only the ones that occur the year before a Jubilee.

*Also these dates are based off of the **assumption** that 1966-67 was a Jubilee year.
